### Content of activities:

#### All Staff

- **Anti-Racism**

In accordance with the Ministry of Education's directions, which emphasize school safety and the fight against racism, one of the mandatory themes of the professional development day focuses on these essential issues. To support this priority and guide staff in this work, a video capsule facilitated by César Ndéma Moussa is provided.

This capsule aims to equip school staff to recognize and prevent racism, adopt inclusive and caring language and practices, and strengthen a climate of safety, belonging, and success for all students.
